Delivery of goods to hard-to-reach places

An oversized (non-standard) cargo is a cargo more than 4.0m in height from the surface of the carriageway, more than 2.5m wide and exceeding the dimensions of the vehicle over a length of 2m or more.

Transportation of goods is carried out on public roads, therefore, the choice of optimal routes for transportation will depend on the total passage of the route and its speed limit. It is impossible not to take into account the individual features of the route: the quality of asphalt pavement, the slope and width of the roadway, the presence of various obstacles in the form of bridges, railway embankments and crossings, as well as the influence of weather conditions and control of road situations.



Types of oversize:

- A heavy cargo is a cargo whose weight, including the mass of the vehicle, exceeds the established weight limits of the vehicle or the load on the vehicle axle;
- Oversized cargo a cargo that protrudes beyond the dimensions of the vehicle from the front or the back more than 1 m or from the side, more than 0.4m from the outer edge of the side lamp.

Each transportation of oversized cargo is carried out in accordance with the requirements of regulatory and legal documents of those countries along which roads are being transported.

For example, in Russia it is "Order of the Ministry of Transport of Russia of January 12, 2018 No. 10 "On approval of the requirements for the organization of movement on the roads of heavy and (or) large vehicles"

- transportation of heavy loads;
- transportation of oversized cargo;
- trucking special equipment;
- registration of permits for transportation;
- organization of special vehicles escort.

Ship types

- Ro-Ro vessel specially equipped vessel for the purpose of transporting large-size cargo, equipment, cars, etc.;
- **Bulk carrier** a vessel for the carriage of goods in bulk (bulk);
- Ferry a type of roller that connects land roads;
- Tanker the most demanded cargo ship for transportation of oil, products produced from it, liquefied gas and other liquid cargo;
- **Container carrier** designed for the carriage of cargo in containers.

Each ship has its own characteristics depending on the type of cargo transported, such as: autonomy, capacity, loading and unloading methods, speed data, ability to withstand weather conditions, restrictions on the navigation area, ability to pass through the Panama or Suez Canals, maintain temperature and atmospheric conditions of cargo holds Currently, maritime transport is an integral part of the global transport system.

To ensure maximum safety when transporting oversized cargo, it is sometimes necessary to use the following escort vehicle along with the carrier throughout the journey. Accompanying our company vehicles, minimizes the risks of

emergency situations during transportation of goods, reduces the load on the driver of an oversized trawl, helping to control the environment and condition of the cargo, as well as informs other road users, carriage in general.

Escort of oversized cargo by a pilot car

Pilot car needed:

- with a cargo width of over 3.5m;
- when the length of a large vehicle is more than 25m and with a width not more than 3.5m;
- when the width of a large vehicle is over 3.5m and the length is more than 25m, 2 pilot cars cover in front and behind;
- in the case when the overhang of the cargo for the rear dimension of a large-sized vehicle is more than 4m;
- in the case when the overall parameter of a large vehicle with or without a load is 4.5 meters or more in height.





AIR FREIGHT
